




### Reformation Sunday

Reformation Sunday is traditionally celebrated on October 31st—on the same day as Halloween – Reformation Day is a Protestant holiday that commemorates the Reformation movement started by Martin Luther in the 16th century.

One of the talking points in Rev. Meggin's message is a quote from Edward Teller. Edward Teller was an American nuclear physicist, known as "the father of the hydrogen bomb":

"When you get to the end of all the light you know and it's time to step into the darkness of the unknown, faith is knowing that one of two things shall happen: either you will be given something solid to stand on, or you will be taught how to fly." — Edward Teller
